Description

Class B is 5 days a week Madrasa class. It is a follow-on class from Class A where students successfully transitioned into structured learning from their time at Illume Stars which has allowed students to focus and adapt to various studies daily.

Expectations and Goals

Arabic

Students starting this class are expected to have already learnt to recognise Arabic letters and the various letter movements covered in the 'Simple Steps in Quran Reading - Part 1 & 2'. The goal will be for students to consolidate their learning and strengthen their foundation. They will do this by completing their 3rd book Madani Qa'idah before looking to move onto the Hafti. The emphasis will remain on setting a solid foundation and understanding as opposed to the speed of completion of books.

Memorisation

Students are expected to have completed Level 1 & 2 of the Dua & Surah book. The goal will be to complete Level 3.

Deeniyat

Students are expected to have a basic understanding of the core practices and beliefs. The goal is to enhance their understanding of the practical aspects including Wudhu, Ghusl and Salah. They will also be introduced to a structured way of learning about the Seerah.
